

NCHENZ Survey Results

Summary of Responses & Historical Comparison

These surveys were conducted by the National Council of Home Educators NZ (NCHENZ). The NCHENZ Executive Committee began surveying the home education community in 2013 on noticing a distinct lack of data about homeschooled children and families in NZ. The Executive uses this information to guide the goals and objectives of NCHENZ, and to inform our meetings with the Ministry of Education and the Education Review Office. 2024 - 769 responses (4742 members), 16% response rate, margin of error 4%, confidence level 95%

2023 - 484 responses (3665 members), 13% response rate, margin of error 5%, confidence level 95%

2022 – 507 responses (2962 members), 17% response rate, margin of error 4%, confidence level 95%

2021 – 855 responses (2496 members), 34% response rate, margin of error 3%, confidence level 95%

2020 – 654 responses (1961 members), 33% response rate, margin of error 4%, confidence level 95%

How many languages are spoken regularly in your home?



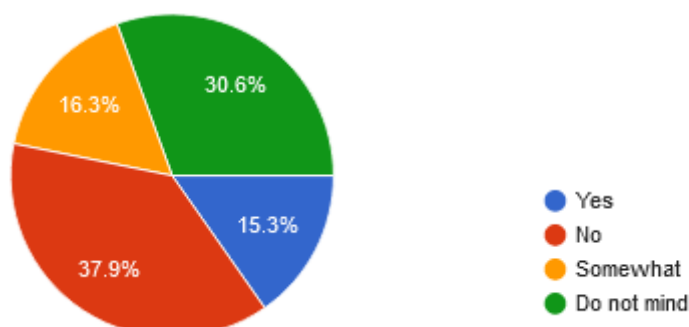

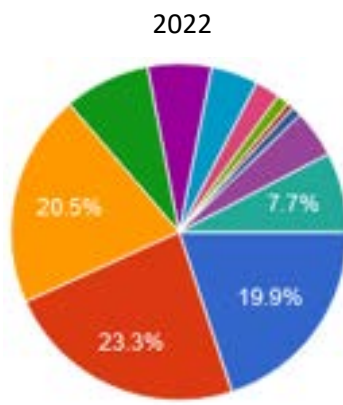
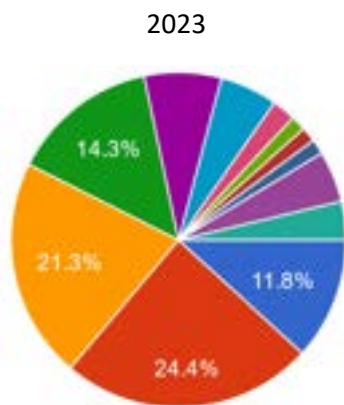
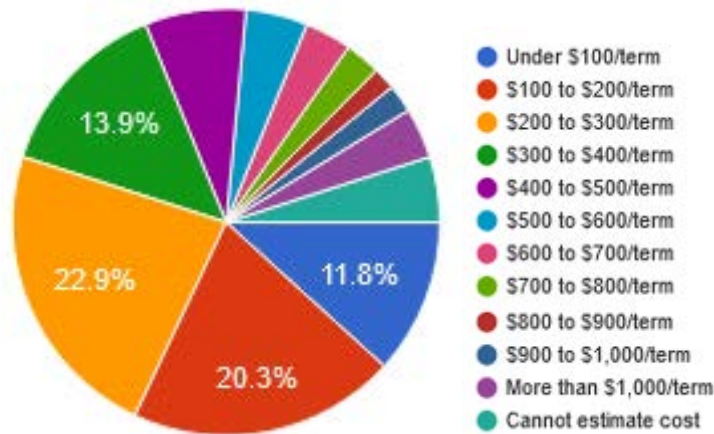


Approximately how much do you spend on educational resources and activities for ONE of your homeschooled children in a typical term?
